Group Classes

Currently, group classes are on Sunday mornings and afternoons. Exact start dates and times are posted periodically on our Facebook page: www.facebook.com/ptcaninecampus

The following are basic group class offerings. These classes meet once a week for five weeks and each session averages 45 minutes but can go up to an hour in length. The price for the full five weeks is \$125 (plus tax) for any of the following options:

Puppy Foundation Obedience

This is a beginner level class for puppies under six months of age who have had little to no previous training. The class focuses on teaching commands such as sit, down, stay, wait, leave it, leash manners, and proper greetings. We also provide guidance for potty training and proper socialization.

Foundation Obedience

This is a beginner level class for dogs 6 months and older who have had little to no previous training. The class focuses on teaching commands such as sit, down, stay, wait, leave it, leash manners, and proper greetings.

Intermediate Obedience

This is a level two class for any age dog that has completed a beginner level class with us or equivalent training elsewhere. The class focuses on increased performance of previously learned skills. Additional skills learned are: Heel, Place, and Target Recall.

Advanced Obedience

This class continues to build on skills learned in the previous levels with an emphasis on preparing dogs to take the AKC Canine Good Citizen test. To enter Advanced class, dogs must have completed Foundation Obedience and Intermediate Obedience (or have received equivalent training elsewhere). At the end of the class, students can choose to schedule and take the CGC test for an additional \$25. *Note: This class is NOT required in order to schedule and take the CGC test - if you already have a dog that is ready for the test, feel free to schedule the test only, separate from any classes.*

Private Lessons

Our private lesson package is customized for the needs of the owner and dog. Dogs of any age can participate. This is a good fit for owners who want to participate in every lesson but also have more specific needs than can be met in a group class setting. This is also a better option for dogs with issues with aggression or reactivity.

Private lessons meet at our facility once a week for five weeks. Each session typically averages around 45 minutes but can go up to an hour in length. **The price for this package is \$305 plus tax.**

Day School

The Day School package is designed for dogs of any age who need help with basic commands or a couple of problem issues (such as pulling on the leash or jumping on guests). This is a great option for those with busy schedules and can be helpful in preventing separation anxiety by getting your dog accustomed to being away from home without you present.

Dogs in Day School receive structured play time throughout the day and an individualized training session based on their needs. For most, this means play breaks with us (the humans) doing activities that work the body *and* the mind. Examples include structured walks (to work on leash manners), tug and/or flirt pole (to work on impulse control), play time with agility equipment, and puzzle toys during nap/kennel time. Our trainer and staff are educated in discouraging unwanted behaviors such as jumping and leash pulling, so even when your dog is not actively in his/her training session with the trainer, he/she is practicing good manners as part of the day.

The Day School package includes six sessions which are scheduled twice a week for three weeks. Drop off time is between 8:30 am and 9:00 am and pick up time is between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm. The price for this package is \$305 plus tax.

3 Week Training Camp

This is our most robust package and our trainer's favorite due to the combination of owner-involvement while still getting the advantage of the trainer getting lots of time to work with your dog one-on-one.

During Training Camp, your dog will board with us from Monday through Friday each week. Each day that he/she is with us, your dog will receive structured activity and training customized toward the needs of you and your pet.

On Friday each week, you pick your dog up (usually in the afternoon or evening - scheduled in advance) and receive a personalized private lesson to go over some of the things your dog learned during the week. This allows for a few huge advantages: 1) You will only be given a couple of things to practice each weekend, so you will not be inundated with a mountain of

information all at once. It's all broken down to make it easier to implement. 2) Practicing at home on the weekend helps the training transition to home life more smoothly. 3) If you run into problems transferring the training at home, you can let the trainer know on Monday when you bring your dog back so she can help troubleshoot or even put more focus on certain items the upcoming week to make sure that the program is working for you and your dog.

You'll receive written progress reports each week as well as a written summary at your dog's final private lesson.

The price for this package is \$1150 plus tax.

Other Offerings:

Remote Collar/E-Collar training can be added to some packages for an additional fee. The trainer can guide you on if this is a good option for you and your pet.

Our trainer can also assist with more specific goals. She has helped many achieve therapy dog certifications and can even help with service dog training.

Periodically, we also offer the AKC S.T.A.R. puppy group classes as well as other specialized group classes such as beginner agility. Specialized classes tend to be an additional week in length and \$150 plus tax for the class.

Note: In order to participate in any program, dogs must be up to date on DHPP (parvo/distemper), bordetella, and rabies vaccines. (Puppies too young to receive the rabies vaccine are exempt from this requirement until old enough.)
